THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA) :

(a) and (e) Government disapprove of resort to violence by any political party or organisation. Under the Constitution, State Governments are entrusted with the responsibility for public order, police and administration of justice. Necessary administrative and > > are taken by them to prevent violent agitations and to deal firmly with any manifestations of violence. The Central Government also provide reasonable assistance to the state Governments, whenever sought.

(b) to (d) Information is being collected.
