DECREASE IN PRODUCTION CAPACITY OF

695. SARDAR D. K. JADHAV: Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that according to a survey conducted by the Rural Agricultural Institute, Bichpuri the production capacity of land in our country has gone down by ten per cent since the beginning of the present century;
- (b) if so, what are the other conclusion of this survey; and
 - (c) the reaction of Government thereto?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD, AGRICUL-TURE, **COMMUNITY DEVELOP-**MENT AND COOPERATION (SHRI ANNASAHEB SHINDE): (a) to (c). In an article published in the Agra University Research Journal 10 years ago (in January 1959) a scholar of the Rural Institute, Bichpuri, Agra, had explained his finding about the decline in the average productivity of land by about 10%. According to him, two problems were behind the decline, namely, the problem of drainage and the other increasing deficiency of humus or organic manure in the soil.

The study is not only out of date but is based upon data which are not directly comparable and which have not been subjected to adjustments. The conclusions are not relevant to the present situation resulting from the technology of the high yielding varieties and multiple cropping programmes.

The trend according to the index numbers compiled in the Department of Agriculture is towards higher productivity, the index numbers having gone up from base line of 100 in 1949-50 to 130.1 for foodgrains, 107.9 for non-foodgrains and 126.6 for all commodities in 1967-68.

PILOT PROJECT TO MAKE SMALL FARMERS CREDIT-WORTHY

697. SHRI Z. A. AHMAD : SHRI SURAJ PRASAD :

Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government have decided to launch a pilot project to help the marginally viable small farmers to become credit worthy and to take to intensive cultivation of high yielding varieties; and
 - (b) if so, the main features thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD, AGRICULTURE, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND COOPERATION (SHRI ANNASAHEB SHINDE): (a) Yes, Madam. The Government have decided to launch a pilot project by establishing Small Farmers Development Agencies to help the marginally viable small farmers to become credit worthy and to take to intensive cuttivation of high-yielding varieties.

(b) The main features of the Pilot project would be as under:

The Small Farmers Development Agencies would be set up in 20/21 selected districts throughout the country during the Fourth Five Year Plan. The Agency would be a registered society.

identify the problems of Agency will small but potentially viable farmers in area and ensue the availability of services inputs and credit to them. It will draw up model plans for investment and production activities to be undertaken by these small farmers. It will coordinate the activities of the existing institutions cooperatives as well as private, bodies such as Zila Parishad and others engaged in the supply of these services and inputs. The agency will provide grants to Central Cooperative Banks, the Agricultural Credit Societies and the Cooperative Land Development Banks to cover their loaning risks for financing such farmers, and to help them build up special funds for the purposes. It will provide subsidy to the cooperative institutions to strengthen their managerial and supervisory staff. It will arrange to provide custom services by supplying agricultural machinery, rigs, tractors. boring equipment on hire at reasonable rates to the small farmers. It will render assistance for development of animal husbandry and poultry to add to the income of the small farmers.

About 50,000 small farmers are likely to be covered during the period of Fourth Five Year Plan in each district.

The details of the schemes are to be finalised in consultation with the local institutions by the Agencies. The scheme has yet to be approved by the Expenditure Finance Committee.
