*An illustrative list of items on which expenditure may be incurred by the Clubs/Associations functioning in residential Colonies of Central Government Employees out of Grants in-Aid sanctioned by the Government of India.*

1. Articles of sports—outdoor and indoor games equipment.
2. Reading Room — Library — Organisation of Book Clubs Magazines and periodicals.
3. Purchase, hire and repair of furniture, fittings etc. of club premises.
4. Hiring of Accommodation for Club/ Association etc.
5. Film shows.
6. Social, Cultural, programme/Sports and Children's functions.
7. Community Health equipment.
8. Conveyance expenses incurred locally.
9. Entertainment.
10. Prizes.
11. Stationery, office equipment etc.

#### BURMESE EDUCATION MINISTER'S TALKS WITH GOVERNMENT

864 SHRI JAGAT NARAYAN : Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES be pleased to state;

(a) whether it is a fact that the Burmese Education Minister during his recent visit to India had held discussions with him; and

(b) if so, the nature of the discussion held and the outcome thereof ?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES (PROF V. K. R. V. RAO) : (a) and (b) The visit of His Excellency Col. Hla Han, Minister for Education of Burma during January, 1969 was primarily a goodwill visit by the Minister of a friendly neighbouring country. During his stay in Delhi the then Education Minister had a general exchange of views with him on subjects of common interest such as primary, technical and university education, and the training of teachers.
