PRODUCTION OF STAINLESS STEEL BY NEW PROGESS

1076. SHRI B. C. PATTANAYAK: Will the Minister of STEEL AND HEAVY ENGINEERING be pleased to state whether in view of the growing shortage of stainless steel what steps do Government propose to take to commercially exploit a new process developed by an Indian Metallurgist of indigenously manufacturing Stainless Steel, which has been patented as Indian Patent Specification No. 91020, and which has already generated wide interest abroad?

Import of low carbon ferromanganese and Jow carbon ferro-alu-minium were desired by Dr. D. R. Malhotra for carrying *out* trial production.
