No occurrence of tin near Bailadilla has been reported.

(b) and (c) Feasibility studies on the establishment of pelletisation plants based on iron ore fines and blue dust from Bailadilla in Madhya Piadesh and Donimalai in Mysore are in progress. Decision on setting up of pelletisation plants can be taken only after the feasibility studies have been completed and the results examined.]

DEFICIT OF NAPHTHA

1150. SHRIMATI LALITHA (RAJA-GOPALAN): Will the Minister of PE-TROLEUM AND CHEMICAS AND MINES AND METALS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the country is expecting to face deficit of naphtha by the year 1975; and
- (b) if so, what steps have been taken to meet the situation?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS 'AND MINES AND METALS (SHRI D. R. CHAVAN):
(a) Yes.

(b) This and related matters are under examination having regard to the quantities of naphtha available, the availabilty of alternative feedstocks for fertilisers and petrochemical industries and the cil refining capacities likely to be developed by 1975.

- (b) whether Government have any scheme for giving financial assistance to cooperative societies formed for running hospitals and if so, the details thereof: and
- (c) whether any such assistance has been given in the past and if so, the names of such hospitals, the amount of the share capital of such societies and the amount of financial assistance given to each of those societies.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING AND WORKS, HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI B. S. MURTHY): (a) The information is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the Sabha.

- (b) The Central Government has no specific scheme for giving financial assistance to cooperative societies formed for running hospitals, but assistance is given from the fund for grants to voluntary bodies.
