INDIAN NATIONALS DETAINED IN PAKISTAN

1283. DR. (MRS.) MANGLADEVI TALWAR : Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state :

(a) the names of Indian nationals at present detained in Pakistan and the period of detention already undergone; and

(b) the efforts made by the Government of India to secure their release ?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI SURENDRA PAL SINGH) : (a) The Government of Pakistan do not furnish information in regard to Indian nationals detained in Pakistan. The Government of India have repeatedly approached the Government of Pakistan in this regard but there has been no response so far.

(b) Every possible effort is made to secure early release of any Indian national, whose detention in Pakistan comes to the notice of the Government.

BASMATI RICE EXPORT

WIG EXPORTS

1285. SHRI M. RUTHNASWAMY : Will the Minister of FOREIGN TRADE AND SUPPLY be pleased to state :

(a) whether the profits from wig exports have fallen this year ; and

(b) if so, the reasons therefor?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN TRADE AND SUPPLY (CHOWDHARY RAM SEWAK) : (a) and (b) The State Trading Corporation incurred losses on the export of wigs last year consequent upon termination of the agreement with its erstwhile sole agents in U.S.A. and Canada and the resultant fall in the total exports. However, the Corporation has been successful in marketing these products in Europe this year and has already reduced its margin of losses in the first four months of the current year.

f [REHABILITATION OF EX-SERVICEMEN

1286. SHRI SURAJ PRASAD : Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state :

(a) the amounts given to each State under the head 'Special Aid Rehabilitation of ex-servicemen's during the last two years and the number of ex-servicemen in each State among whom the said amounts have been distributed; and

(b) what is the rule regarding sanctioning of loans and grants to the ex-servicemen from these funds ?]

रक्षा मंत्रालय में उपमंत्री (श्री एम० आर० कृष्ण) : (क) सदस्य महोदय का इशारा शायद भूतपूर्व सैनिकों के पुनर्स्थापन तथा पुनरावास के लिए विशेष निधि की सम्पत्तियों से राज्यों/संघीय क्षेत्रों को आवंटनों की ओर है। 1 जनवरी, 1965 और 1 जनवरी, 1966 तक क्रमशः राज्य सघीय विशेष से, सशस्त्र सेनाओं में भर्ती किए गए सेवा सेवानिवृत्त संख्या के आधार पर अकेले-अकेले राज्यों-संघीय क्षेत्रों को वितरण के लिए 1965-66 और 1966-67 वर्षों में प्रत्येक के दौरान 80 लाख रुपये की राशि आवंटित की गई है। राज्य-संघीय क्षेत्र की प्रबन्ध समितियों द्वारा इन राशियों के प्रयोग तक 1967-68 और 1968-69 वर्षों के लिए केन्द्रीय सरकार द्वारा और कोई आवंटन नहीं किया गया।

(ख) विशेष निधि के प्रशासन के लिए योजना के अनुसार यह इन उद्देश्यों के लिए प्रयोग में लाई जा सकती है :

(1) मान्य प्रशिक्षण संस्थाओं में तकनीकी, प्रबंध संबंधी, व्यावसायिक या कृषि प्रशिक्षण के लिए भूतपूर्व सैनिकों के स्टिपेंड देने के लिए।

(2) पुनरावास के लिए योजनाओं और प्रायोजनाओं के लिए भूतपूर्व सैनिकों की सहकारी समितियों या अन्य समितियों को
