

## SCRAPPING OF SUGAR CONTROL

1539. SHRI JAGAT NARAIN: Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether in view of the marked increase in sugar production during the current year Government proposes to scrap the sugar control; and

(b) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD, AGRICULTURE, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND COOPERATION (SHRI ANNASAHEB SHINDE): (a) and (b) The sugar policy for 1969-70 will be considered shortly in consultation with the State Governments and other interests concerned.
