

(b) The deficiencies brought out by the Hotel Review & Survey Committee in respect of these restaurants will be communicated to the lessees for taking immediate action to bring the catering service up to the desired level, failing which action to replace them will be taken.

URDU TRANSLATION OF MAHABHARAT

*79. SHRI A 3ID ALI : Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES be pleased to state :

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the Urdu translation of the Mahabharat which is being published in the daily "Inqilab" of Bombay in the form of poetry; and

(b) if so, whether Government propose to reward the poet and publishers for the same?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES (PROF. V. K. R. V. RAO) : (a) Government has been informed that some parts of Maha-bharat have been translated in Urdu and published in the daily 'Inqilab'.

(b) The proposal for grant of reward to the poet and publishers would be considered on merit when the translation has been completed and the same has been submitted to the Ministry of Education and Youth Services.

DEVELOPING KOVALAM BEACH (KERALA) AS TOURIST CENTRE

*80 SHRI UALACHANDRA ME-NON : Will the Minister of TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether the scheme to develop the Kovalam beach in Kerala as a first class tourist centre has been finalised;

(b) if so, what are the main details thereof; and

(c) the estimated cost of the scheme?

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (DR. KA-RAN SINGH) : (a) Final approval has yet to be given to the plans and estimates submitted recently by the architect.

(b) Salient features of the Project are construction of a hotel, some beach cottages, a beach centre with cafeteria

and shops, and provision of recreational facilities.

(c) Rs. 90 lakhs, to be shared by the Department of Tourism and the India Tourism Development Corporation.

MYSORE CHIEF MINISTER'S STATEMENT ON SENAS

(a) whether the question of readjusting the Centre-State relations with a view to strengthen the State's autonomy has been considered by Government; and

(b) if so, what steps are being taken in this respect ?

THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI Y. B. CHAVAN) : (a) and (b) Government are examining the report of the Administrative Reforms Commission on Centre-State Relationships.

EXTENSION TO CLASS I OFFICERS OF THE EDUCATION MINISTRY

(a) the number of Class I officers of his Ministry who were given extension
