- (c) if so, by when Government propose to remove these shortcomings and if not, what are the reasons therefor?]

MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF GOMMUNICATI ONS (PROF. SHER SINGH: (a) No. According to departmental standard only one post of Extra departmental Mail peon is justified for Bariarpur sub-Post Office. Recently one extra Departmental messanger has also been sanctioned.

(b) and (c) There is some shortage of ccommodation for staff in the Bariarpur Sub Post Office. However, a proposal for the construction of P. O. building and staff quarters is under examination of the department. Telephone Service is available at Bariarpur.]

FAMINE AFFECTED AREAS

- 367. SARDAR HARGHARAN SINGH DUGAL: Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:
- (a) the names of regions in the country which are at present declared as famine affected areas in different States and how long famine conditions have continued to exist there so far;
- (b) whether any Study Team of the Planning Commission has recently visited those areas and if so, what is their assessment of the prevailing conditions there;
- (c) whether the Study Team has made any recommendations to remove famine conditions from those areas and to provide help to the famine striken people and if so, the details thereof: and
- (d) the decision taken by Government on the recommendations?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD, AGRICULTURE, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND CO-OPERATRON (SHRI ANNASAHEB SHINDE): (a) No State Government have reported declaration of any area as famine affected area. However, owing to the failure of rains in 1968-69, drought conditions have appeared in parts of some States. A list of the Stales affected is attached. (Statement I). (See below).

(b) to (d) Central Teams are sent to States affected by drought to assess the requirements of funds fot immediate relief operations. A Statement indicating the ceilings of expenditure, recommended by the Teams, during 1968-69 and 1969-70 and the assistance released so for is attached (Statement II). No request for sending a Central team to Bihar had been received from the State Government.

PRODUCTION OF FERTILIZERS

368. SARDAR HARGHARAN SINGH DUGAL: Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government have recently-reviewed the position with regard to the availability and consumption of fertilizers *visa-vis* its requirements during 1970 in the country; and
- (b) if so, the details of the assessment made by Government and the action taken for the production of fertilizers to meet the country's requirements?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD. AGRICULTURE, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND CO-(SHRI ANNASAHEB OPERATION SHINDE): (a) and (b) The fertiliser consumption requirements of the country for the year 1970-71 have been tentatively estimated at 20 lakh tonnes of Nitrogen, 8 lakh tonnes of P2O5 and 4 lakh tonnes of K2O. The position will, however, require to be reviewed after the level of consumption reached during 1969-70 is known. According to the assessment made by Government, the production of fertilizers will be of the order of 12*28 lakh tonnes of nitrogen and 4 10 lakh tonnes of P2O5 during 1970-71. It is proposed to establish additional fertiliser factories and expand the existing ones to meet the requirements to the extent possible.
