- (b) The old Committee has been in continuous existence over a long period with individual member; retiring and new ones appointed in their places. The new Committee is proposed to be constituted shortly.
- (c) Yes, Madain. The subject-matter specialists for the new Committee have been selected after informal consultation with State Government. This, however, took place before the present Government assumed office. The names of the Members of the State Legi lature will be finalised after consultation with the Chief Minister.
- (d) Experts from different fields of specialisation whose advice is likely to be useful for determining programme patterns are appointed or these committees and panels.
