(b) The procedure for release of Central assistance to State Governments for their plan schemes has been revised from 1969-70. Assistance will now be released to States in block loans and grants for the annual plan as a whole and will not be related to any individual programme or sector. Assistance proposed to be given to States for their annual plan schemes including Agricultural programme is given in the enclosed statement. The assistance will be released to State Governments towards the end of the financial year 1969-70 on the basis of the expenditure figures furnished by the State Governments.
