## CLOSURE OF A LEPROSY HOSPITAL

\*154. SHRI A. G. KULKARNI: t SHRI G. R. PATIL: SHRI S. B. BOBDEY:

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING AND WORKS, HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government are aware of the recent Press Report about the closure of a Leprosy Hospital run by a Foreign Mission near Satara;
- (b) if so, what are the reasons therefor; and
- (c) whether the Central Govern ment give any grants to hospitals run by foreign missionaries and if so, the names of such institutions and the amount given to them?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTFI AND FAMILY PLANNING AND WORKS, HOUSING AND URBAN IMATLOPMENT (SHRI B. S. MURTHY): (a) Yes, Madam. The American Marathi Mission, Satara, has stopped leprosy control work since 25th January, 1969.

- (b) There were differences between the American Marathi Mission and the workers; and
- (c) All voluntary medical institutions are eligble for grants-in-aid from Government, if they fulfil the prescribed conditions. Information regarding the names of foreign missionary institutions and the grants received by them will be compiled and placed on the Table of the Sabha.

SHRI A. G. RULKARNI: Madam, may I know from the Government the specific reply to part (b) of the question—"if so, what are the reasons therefor?" Particularly I would like to know from the Minister why the American Presbyterian Mission decided to close down the hospital. I want to have a specific reply to my question whether he is aware that an application has been preferred to the Home Minister of the Government of India that the American Mission is increasingly putting obstacles in the path of the Indian Christians who are running these hospitals but who are not toeing the line of the main body, COMAR as it is called in America, or the United Church of North India, the parent body in India.

SHRI B. S. MURTHY/ Madam, from the information that we have now with us, it seems that the missionary people wanted the lepers to be converted into Christianity, and the workers did not like it.

SHRI A. G. KULKARNI: "Workers" means Indian Christians?

SHRI B. S. MURTHY. No.

SHRI A. G. KULKARNI: Who are the workers?

SHRI B. S. MURTHY: There is one Mr. Mahanti in charge of the v. orkers . . .

SHRI A. G. KULKARNI: Is he not an Indian Christian?

SHRI B. S. MURTHY: We do not know.

SHRI MORARJI R. DESAI: He must be an Indian Christian.

SHRI B. S. MURTHY: We do not have the information. If I sa\ he is an Indian Christian and tomor row it is found that he is not an Indian Christian and he is a worker

..... Therefore, as far as we know there was a dispute between the mis sionaries and the workers there undei the leadership of Mr. Mahanti. The missionaries wanted the conversion oi the patients suffering from leprosy and the workers said "No." There fore, perhaps the funds are withheld and it is not being run now.

**SHRIMATI** SHAKUNTALA PA RANJPYE: I would like to know the number of in-patients and out patients at this leprosy hospital.

SHRI B. S. MURTHY: We dc not have the break-up.

SHRI A. G. KULKARNI: Ma> I know from the Government whe ther they can assure us that this hos pital which has been closed down noi for a rightful cause but due to some ulterior motive of the American Pres byterian Mission, will be re-started b) the Government and the lepers whe were treated there will be treated because this is a very urgent necessity in that area as a lepers' colony has been started there and because ol these moves of the American Mission that has been stopped?

SHRI B. S. MURTHY: Madam medical care, as the hon. Member i < aware, is under provincial autonomy and if the State Government is willing to undertake it, we shall be ven happy to assist in all possible

- (a) whether it is a fact that the three units of the Indian Drugs and Pharmaceuticals Ltd., located at Rishikesh, Madras and Hyderabad, incurred a loss of nearly one crore of rupees in the year 1968; and
  - (b) if so, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS AND MINES AND METALS (SHRI D. R. CHA-

VAN): (a) The loss incurred by the Indian Drugs and Pharmaceuticals Limited during the year ended March, 1968 was Rs. 232.54 lakhs including depreciation and interest on loans

- (b) The main reasons for the loss are:
- (i) The year was one of completion of erection, start-up, trial production and commissioning for industrial production of the Antibiotics and Synthetic Drugs Plants Rishikcsh and Hyderabad respectively\*^^
- (ii) Low production of the Surgical Instruments plant at Madras. mainly on account of lack of demand.

श्री निरंजन वर्मा: क्या श्रीमान यह बतलायेंग कि जहां पर यह तीनों फैक्ट-रियां स्थित हैं उन स्थानों पर कच्चे माल की श्रौर इस प्रकार के श्रौषधि के कच्चे भंडार की बहुत कमी है जिस के कारण भंडार को औषधियां मिल नहीं अप्रीर इस वजह से ही वह बराबर हानि में रन कर रहे हैं।
