- (a) whether the attention of Gov ernment has been drawn to a report published in the 'Hindustan Times' dated the 13th March, 1969 to the effect that Reserve Bank officials da not know how to implement the relaxations regarding foreign travel announced recently by the Union Finance Ministry;
- (b) if so, the reaction of Government in this regard; and
- (c) whether the Reserve Bank has communicated its difficulties in this regard to Government?

THE DEPUTY PRIME MINIS TER AND MINISTER OF FINANCE (SHRI MORARII R. DFSAI): (a) Yes, Madam.

INCIDENCE OF CANCEB

- 714. SHRI S. A. KHAJA MOHI-DEEN: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING AND WORKS, HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that Dr. D. |. Jussuwalla, Founder-Secretary of the Indian Cancer Society, observed that about five lakhs of people-die of cancer in India every year; and
- (b) if so, what positive steps Government propose to take to fight cancer?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING AND WORKS, HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI B. S. MURTHY): (a) The Government is not aware of Dr. Jussawalla's findings. According to the report of the Cancer Committee (1966) about 2 lacs persons die annually of Cancer in tlie country.

(()) The Government is encouraging research in the causation and treat men t of cancer. Cancer research centres exist at Calcutta, Madras and Bombay. There are 81 Cobalt units lor radio therapy in the country. Assistance is also given by the Central Government for obtaining Cobalt units for Radio Therapy. Surgical treatment of operable cases of cancer is given free to poor pa-tic nts in all General Hospitals in the country, where adequate facilities are available. The Indian Cancer So-eiei\ is publishing periodically literature giving early symptoms and warning signals of cancer with a view to detect cases of cancer as early as possible.
