## DIRECTOR OF I.I.E.M., CALCUTTA

787. SHRI M. P. BHARGAVA: Will tin-Minister of EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a'fact that the recently appointed Director of the Indian Institute for Experimental Medicine; Calcutta, undei the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research does not have any medical qualification;

(b) the reasons for appointing a nonmedical person to direct research activities of a medical Institute in preference persons with high medical qualifications; and

(c) whether the Institute could not more appropriately be located under the Indian Council of Medical Research?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES (PROF. V. K. R. V. RAO): (a) The present Director of the Indian Institute of Experimental Medicine. Calcutta, has no medical qualification as such but is an eminent Chemist and lire been working as Head of the Chemistn Department and Deputy Director of the School of Tropical Medicine. Calcutta, since 1948.

(b) The Institute of Experimental Medicine is not a medical institute where clinical work is undertaken. It is well-known that chemistry forms an essential basis of medicine. Qualifications prescribed for the posi of Director when it was advertised, covered all the scientific disciplines related to the objectives and programme of the Institute. Medical qualifications were also prescribed. The present incumbent was adjudged to be the best candidate by a duly constituted expert Selection Committee in accordance with the relevant Bye-laws.

(c) The Study Team on Scientific Departments of the Administrative Reforms Commission is looking into this matter.
