(a) the total assets upto December, 1968 and the Annual Income during 1967-68 of the Hindu, Muslim, Christian and Parsee religious endowments, Wakfs, Secular Trusts and Charities in the country : and

(b) whether Government have any proposal to utilise these resources for economic development of the country?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI P. C. SETHI) : (a) Information is not available regarding the total assets and annual incomes of the religious and charitable institutions in the country. There has been no occasion to collect this information, as under Section 5(1)(i) of the Wealth Tax Act, 1957, property held under trust for any public purpose of a charitable or religious nature, is exempt from wealth tax, and under Section 11 of the Income-tax Act, 1961, income from such a property is exempt from income-tax. However, declarations were received regarding gold held by religious institutions under the Gold Control Regulations, and

the estimated quantity of gold declared by all religious institutions in the country is as follows:—

#### INDIAN DRUGS AND PHARMACEUTICALS LTD.

(a) whether it is a fact that the Indian Drugs and Pharmaceuticals Ltd., a public sector undertaking manufacturing surgical instruments, synthetic drugs and antibiotics, suffered a heavy loss during the year 1967-68;

(b) the amount of loss suffered during the said period ;

(c) if so, the reasons for the undertaking running into loss ; and

(d) the steps taken by Government to make the undertaking into a profitable one ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS AND MINES AND METALS (SHRI D. R. CHAVAN) : (a) Yes, Sir. Indian Drugs and Pharmaceuticals Ltd. suffered a loss in 1967-68.

(b) Rs. 232-533 lakhs including depreciation and interest on loans.

(c) The main reasons for the loss are

(i) The year was one of completion of erection, start-up, trial production and commissioning for industrial

production of the Antibiotics and synthetic Drugs Plants :

(ii) Low production of the Surgical Instruments plant on account of lack of demand.

(d) The steps taken and under contemplation are :—

(i) Stabilisation of the production of different items and improvement of processes wherever possible.

(ii) Restriction of imports of the items in the production programme of the Company,

(iii) diversification of the product-mix of the surgical plant,

(iv) reduction in the capital overheads of the Surgical project.

(v) progressive reduction in staff wherever practicable.

(c) if so, what are the reasons for over production ?

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS AND MINES AND METALS(DR. TRIGUNASEN): (a) The refineries have been allowed at present to operate at the capacities as under for purposes of foreign exchange allocations for the import of crude oil :

The industrial licences issued to these refineries specify a capacity of 1-9 million ton for ESSO and 2-0 million ton for Burmah-shell.
