EXPORTS OF RAILS TO IRAN

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL AND HEAVY ENGINEERING (SHRI K. C. PANT): Trial rolling of the rail section required by the Iranian State Railway has been taken up in the Bhilai Steel Plant. All othei arrangements for executing the order according to schedule have been made. The first shipment is expected to be made in April-May 1969.

TRAINING OF TECHNICIANS FOR STEEL PLANTS IN IRAN

- 641. CHAUDHARY A. MOHAMMAD: Will the Minister of STEEL ANDHEAVY ENGINEERING be pleased to' state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that the Hindustan Steel Limited is likely to train 500 technicians for the Government owned Steel Plant in Iran:
- (b) if so, whether an} agreement has been signed with the Government of Iran in this regard; and

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL AND HEAVY ENGINEERING (SHRI K.C. PANT):
(a) to (c) Hindustan Steel Limited have, subject to confirmation by the Governments of India and Iran, entered into an agreement with the National tranian Steel Corporation, Teheran, for the training of about 509 Iranian personnel in its Plants. The agreement has been approved by the Government of India.

According to the agreement, training will be imparted for periods varying from 3 to 15 months for different groups of trainees and will be spread over till about the end of 1971. The National Iranian Steel Corporation will pay to HSL the necessary training costs and reimburse other expenses connected therewith in U.S. Dollars.
