- (a) the total area of India as in 1934 as on tst November, 1947 and today;
- (b) if there is a difference in these three figures, what is the extent of the difference and the reasons therefor in detail; and
- (c) the total area of Indian islands in the past and at present?]

There are many islands big and small, some just jutting out of the waters, certain islands along our coast, some near and some at a little distance, and we are making an accurate survey of all of them. SHRI M. M. DHARIA: Mr. Chairman, Sir,

We expect and this House expects from the honourable Minister that the Government should be in a position to know what are the number of islands which belong to this country of ours. Now he is saying, "We are making a survey". This shows that the Government is still not aware what our own territory is. I feel, Sir, that it ia a very serious matter. Instead of making any such statement today let the honourable Minister take his time, but we would like to know what the exact number of our islands is. By this time the Government should be

in a position to know what the number of our islands is. It reflects seriously on the Government

Oral Any.

SHRI DINESH SINGH: Now that the honourable Member has given me another opportunity to clarify the position, so far as the boundary of...

SHRI PITAMBER DAS: Sir, let me put my question.

MR. CHAIRMAN: Let him explain. 1 shall allow you.

SHRI DINESH SINGH: So far as the the boundary of a country along the water is concerned, it is the territorial water, not the line linking islands. The islands falling within our territorial waters are our islands. 1 was trying to say . . . (Interruptions) . . . I had tried to mention that we have about 1,300 islands. Some are very small, some arc big. Depending upon our resources, we have been trying to make a more accurate survey of this and therefore I wanted to leave this position in the minds of Members that these are there. Some of them are just rocks jutting out and there are islands with specific areas. We are going into it with the latest techniques available. We are going to make a survey as in the case of land. It is a process in which the latest technological development is employed like aerial photography, to assess more accurately, but according to our present estimates, I said we have 1300 islands in our territorial waters.

SHRI M. M. DHARI A: My point oi order remains. There are countries like Ceylon which are, that way, within the territorial waters also and naturally we should be in a position to know the exact number of islands within our jurisdiction and from that point of view I wanted exact information from the Minister

SHRI DINESH SINGH: That is what 1 was trying to say. We have the Islands of the Andamans and the Nicobar Islands. They also create territorial waters around them. Therefore each small island has to be measured and has to be assessed. That is why I said that while we have an idea of our boundary as such, the exact number, according to us. is this. As more survey is carried out we may have a more specific number.

SHRI PIT AMBER DAS: What was the number of islands that we inherited in 1947? You may be still finding out, I can unerstand that. But what was the number that we inherited in 1947?

SHRI DINESH SINGH: We did not inherit. They were our islands. Where is the question of inheritance? You say as if somebody gave them to us. That is not the position.

SHRI PITAMBER DAS: Ihe British Government, when il quit office, left certain things for us. I want to know what was the number when they left this country in 1947? It is 21 years now. Let us know the number at that time.

SHRI DINESH SINGH: 1 cannot say what was the number when the British left because we have now a more accurate assessment of our position in the sea.

MR. CHAIRMAN: The whole trouble is this. There are nearly 9 Members who have put this question. Those who are not here in the list ave taking a greater part than those who have put the question originally.
