

(d) how many scientists from our National Laboratories had left service in 1967?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES (PROF. V. K. R. V. RAO): (a) No Director of a National Laboratory/Institute resigned in 1967. However, Dr. R. B. Arora, Director, Indian Institute of Experimental Medicine, Calcutta who was on deputation from the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi expressed a desire to go back to his parent office in 1967 at the end of his term of one year due to his family circumstances.

(b) No Director expressed a desire to resign in 1967.

(c) (i) One Director accepted a foreign assignment in August, 1966 and has continued in that position. He resigned from the CSIR with effect from 23rd August, 1968.

(ii) Another Director has been permitted to accept a foreign assignment for short periods of 6-8 weeks each year for a period of 4-5 years from 1967.

(d) Five Scientists in the scale of Rs. 700—50—1,250 and two Scientists in the scale of Rs. 1300—60—1600 left CSIR in 1967. Information regarding the lower categories is maintained in the laboratories. This is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the House.

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES (PROF. V. K. R. V. RAO): (a) No, Sir.

(b) Does not arise.

(c) The remedies rest primarily with the State Governments. Universities, and political and economic leadership in the country. On the educational side, the University Grants Commission has been assisting universities for implementing programmes of students' welfare with a view to providing a congenial atmosphere for study and research and thus divert their attention from undesirable activities.

In addition, the Ministry of Education and Youth Services is having under consideration possibilities of promoting programmes of youth services that will also serve to deal with the problem of student unrest.
