REPRESENTATION FROM OSMANIA University

640. SHRI Y. ADINARAYANA REDDY: Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Osmania University has made a representation to the Government of India for funds for the running of the 'Advance Centre in Animal genetics'; and 'the scheme on induction of sterility in large animals by use of Radioisotopes'; and
- (b) if so, what action Government have taken on the representation?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD, AGRICULTURE, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND COOPERATION (SHRI ANNASAHEB SHINDE): (a) Proposals for sanction of funds for establishment of an "Advance Centre in Animal Genetics" and scheme for "Induction of sterility in large animals by use of Radioisotopes" were submitted by the Osmania University to the Indian Council of Agricultural Research.

(b) A sum of Rs. 88,000 was paid to the Osmania University during 1966-67 on an ad hoc basis for purchase of equipment for running the Advance Centre in Animal Genetics. In addition, approval of the Council for creation of three posts of Readers and three

posts of Technicians has been conveyed to the University during 1967-68 and funds for this will be released after the position relating to appointment on the posts is intimated to the Council. A sum of Rs. 2 lakhs has been remitted to the Osmania University during 1968-69 to start the scheme on induction of sterility in large animals by use of Radioisotopes.

SUGAR PROCUREMENT AND EXPORT

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD, AGRICULTURE, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND COOPERATION (SHRI ANNASAHEB SHINDE): (a) and (b) There was complete control over the price and distribution of sugar during 1965-66, 1967 and up to 23rd November, 1967. Thereafter, only 60 per cent of production is being procured for controlled distribution. The quantity of sugar procured and the price range during 1966, 1967 and 1968 are given below:
