†[LEVEL CROSSINGS ON RAILWAY LINE PASSING THROUGH BIKANER CITY

719. SHRI KUMBHA RAM ARYA: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Railway level crossings on the Railway line passing through the city of Bikaner remain closed for most of the time on account of heavy Railway traffic causing great inconvenience to the people;
- (b) whether the people of Bikaner have long been representing for relief from this inconvenience; and
- (c) if so, what action has been taken by Government in this regard?

रेल मंत्री (श्री सी० एम० पुनाचा): (क) जी, नहीं! यद्यपि गाड़ियों के संचलन के लिए समपार फाटकों को बन्द करना पड़ता है फिर भी फाटक ज्यादा देर तक बन्द नहीं रहते। सड़क यातायात को कम से कम समय के लिए रोका जाता है।

- (ख) जी, हां।
- (ग) बीकानेर स्टेशन के दोनों ओर एक-एक सड़क ऊपरी पुल की व्यवस्था करने का आवश्यक प्रस्ताव 1961 में किया गया था लेकिन स्थानीय लोगों के विरोध के कारण यह योजना आगे नहीं बढ़ सकी और राज्य सरकार के अनुरोध पर प्रस्ताव को अन्तिम रूप से छोड़ना पड़ा।

†[THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI C. M. POONACHA): (a) No. Although the level crossing gates have to be closed for train movements, the gates do not remain closed for most of the time. The hold-up to the road traffic is kept down to the minimum.

- (b) Yes.
- (c) Necessary proposal to provide two road over-bridges, one on either side of Bikaner Station, was formulated in 1961, but the schemes could not be progressed further due to apposition from local people; and proposals had to be dropped finally at the request of the State Government.]
