THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SHRI BHAGWAT JHA AZAD) : (a)

Yes, Madam. Except schools under the Delhi Municipal Corporation where education is free upto Higher Secondary stage.

(b) Fees are charged in two grades in terms of article 112 of Delhi Education Code according to which children of parents whose income is not less than Rs. 5,000 per annum pay higher tuition fee than the rest for the reason that parents who can afford should pay higher fees. These two grades existed before 1947.

(c) No additional benefits are given to students paying 1st grade fee.

(d) There is no specific proposal to this effect at present.
