(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the news item published in 'Patriot' on the 4th June, 1968 to the effect that Dr. Malder editor of 'CIA who's Who' has stated that M/s. C. G. Cogan, E.A. Marelius and P. K. Peterson had been identified as C.I.A. spies in New Delhi;

(b) if so, whether Government have instituted any inquiry into the matter; and

(c) if the reply to part (b) above be in the affirmative, what are the findings thereof and action taken thereon?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA): (a) Yes, Madam.

(b) and (c) The matter has been looked into carefully. The three individuals named in the news item published in the 'Patriot' dated June 4, 1968 did not come to any adverse notice while they were serving in India, between 1957 and 1962.

[See Appendix LXV, Annexure No. 50.] Enrolment in urban areas by levels of Education is not available.

(b) Total direct expenditure on Education in 1964-65 in urban areas was Rs. 230.37 crores out of which Rs. 173.72 crores was from Government funds (Central and State).

(c) The total number of educational institutions in the urban areas was 1,33,314.
