CLOSURE OF TEXTILE MILLS IN MAHABASHTRA

\*407. SHRI M. ASAD MADANI: Will the Minister of LABOUR AND REHABILITATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that 8,500 workers were recently rendered jobless by the closure of five textile mills in Maharashtra;

(b) if so, whether any alternative jobs have been provided to these workers; and

(c) what were the causes of the closure of the factories?

TELEPHONE EXCHANGE AT SITAPUR

(c) the number of complaints received about wrong billing and general behaviour of the staff?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF PARLIAMEN-TARY AFFAIRS AND COMMUNICA-TIONS (SHRI I. K. GUJRAL): (a) The automatic telephone exchange at Sitapur was commissioned on 31st March, 1967.

(b) 320 complaints were received regarding its unsatisfactory working over a period of 16 months.

(c) Over a period of 16 months, 70 complaints were received regarding wrong billing and 3 specific complaints against rude behaviour of the staff.

SALE OF LAND FOR DISPLACED PERSONS IN DELHI
