DRINKING WATER IN THE FOURTH FIVE YEAR PLAN

- *27. SHRI RAMNIWAS MIRDHA: Will the Minister of HEALTH, FAMILY PLANNING AND WORKS, HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:
- (a) the amount of money that has been allocated for the rural and urban drinking water schemes during the Fourth Five Year Plan; and
- (b) what special effort is being made for rural water supply during the Gandhi Centenary Year?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH, FAMILY PLANNING AND WORKS, HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI K. K. SHAH): (a) and (b). The Planning Commission have proposed tentatively a provision of Rs. 336.00 crores

in the State Sector for the National Water Supply and Sanitation Programme (Urban and Rural). The need of paying special attention to rural water supply schemes is being impressed on the State Governments. The Gandhi Centenary Committee are exploring ways and means of increasing rural water supply and are trying to persuade State Governments to undertake this work.

AWARD TO OFFICERS OF CUSTOMS DEPARTMENTS

*28. SHRI THILLAI VILLALAN: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is any proposal to give awards to officers who were responsible for apprehending culprits engaged in smuggling in this country;
- (b) the number of big hauls unearthed during the year 1967-68 and the designations of officers who unearthed them; and
- (c) whether they have been given awards?
 THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE
 MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI P. C.
 SETHI): (a) The President has already
 instituted a scheme of awards. Under
 this scheme, two types of Presidential awards
 are given to the officers and staff of the
 Central Excise, Customs and Narcotics
 Departments and the Enforcement Directorate, namely:—
- (i) Appreciation Certificate for exceptionally meritorious service rendered even at the risk of life.
- (ii) Appreciation Certificate for specially distinguished record of service.
- (b) 25 big hauls in which the value of the seized goods exceeded Rs. 10 lakhs in each case were made during 1967-68. Various categories of officers such as Preventive Inspectors, Preventive Officers, Principal Appraisers, Appraisers, Examiners and Sepoys in the Customs Department; Superintendents, Deputy Superintendents, Inspectors, Sub-Inspectors and Sepoys in the Central Excise Department; Deputy Superintendents, Inspectors, Sub-Inspectors, Assistant Sub-Inspectors, Head Constables and Constables of the Police Department took part in these seizures;
