REFERENCE TO NON-VACATION OF A BUNGALOW ALLOTTED TO SARDAR RAM SINGH

SHRI LOKANATH MISRA (Orissa) : Madam, I wan to bring to your kind notice and to the ne ice of Irs hon, that there has been some difficulty about ihe allotment of a house from the Rajya Sabha quota, and after I bring il co your notice, probably the House would star, condemning the way a Member of another House has occupied it forcibly, and in spite of the fac: that the matter has been brought to the notice of the Chairman oi' the Rajya Sabha, the Prime Minister and the Minister of Parliamentary Affairs, nothing has been done, he could not be porsuaded to vacate the house even though it belongs io the Rajya Sabha quota. U. t'mately what happene was that when after a talk with the Parliamentary Affairs Minister yesterday and knowing it from him that ihe house in question has been allotted to him Sardar Ram Singh approached the Member of the other House to make over the house to him, he telephoned the flying squad of the police. It has now gone to the police. I am surprised *o find that the matter had to go to the police. Even though he belongs to a particular party, even though he belongs to the ruling parly, nothing could be done to vacate him from the house. Now where have we come to ? It affects the dignity of this House. The house belongs to the Rajya Sabha quota, and once it has been allotted to a Member of the Rajya Sabha, how is it that a Member of another House, who belongs to the ruling party, forcibly got into it and is still keeping possession of it

SOME HON. MEMBERS : This is serious.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN : I have given only permission to Sardar Ram Singh and in his absence to Mr. Lokanath Misra to mention this. But I feel that it is very unfortunate that Members of Parliament should do this and I would draw the attention—as Mr. Lokanath Misra has drawn—attention to this especially of the Minister cf Parliamentary Affairs that this mus put right immediately. It is rather—what shall I say—in abominable thing that Members of the two Houses should do this. I hope the Parliamentary Affairs Minister will look into it and put it right immediately.
