#### NATIONAL PLAYING FIELDS SCHEME

\*562. SHRI ARJUN ARORA:  
SHRI GULAM NABI UNTOO:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES be pleased to state:

(a) whether any playgrounds have been got ready under the National Playing Fields Scheme; and

(b) if so, the location thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES (SHRI BHAKT DARSHAN): (a) and (b) There is no National Playing Fields Scheme as such; but a National Play Fields Centre is being developed on a plot of land, measuring about 110 acres, south of Rajghat at New Delhi. About 20 acres of this land is being used temporarily for Gandhi Centenary Exhibition. The rest of the land is expected to be levelled shortly. Tentative drawings for play-fields for several sports and an Indoor Stadium, proposed to be provided for there, are under submission to the Delhi Development Authority. The construction work will start as soon as necessary formalities are completed and final working drawings are ready.
