

†[THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES (PROF. V. K. R. V. RAO): (a) Under the Centrally sponsored scheme of book production in regional languages at university level, the Government of India has agreed to provide upto a sum of Rs. one crore to each of the State Governments for production of university level books in regional languages during the next

five years. The Government of India in collaboration with universities concerned will arrange writing of books in Urdu at university level.

So far a sum totalling Rs. 32,47,828.00 has been released for writing of books in regional languages, to State Governments as indicated below:
