(b) what is the number of mills that are lying closed for more than a year or two and the total number of workers who have been rendered out of job thereby?

THE MINISTER OF COMMERCE (SHRI DINESH SINGH): (a) 23 mills remaining closed at the end of October, 1968 had closed down during the previous six months.

(b) 19 cotton textile mills are lying closed for more than one year out of which 9 are lying closed for more than 2 years. The number of workers on roll in these mills is about 29700.

POONACHA): (a) Fodder to destinations in drought affected districts of Rajasthan is being offered for despatch by rail only from stations on the Northern, Central and Western Railways. During the period from 1st September to 23rd November, 1968. 638 Broad Gauge and 5066 Metre Gauge wagons were loaded with fodder from these Railways to drought affected destinations in Rajasthan.

- (b) Yes.
- (c) Famine concession rates for fodder from a number of stations on Northern, Western and Central Railways to stations in the famine affected areas of Rajasthan have been introduced as requested by the Government of Rajasthan. The concessional rate is 14 paise per B.G. 4-wheeled wagon per Kilometre subject to a minimum charge of Rs. 10 per wagon and 9.5 paise per M. G. 4wheeled wagon per Kilometre subject to a minimum charge of Rs. 5 per wagon.
