THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH, FAMILY PLANNING AND URBAN DEVELOP-MENT (SHRI B. S. MURTHY): (a) The demarcation of land in Pitampura area has been completed and actual sites have also been shown to the Cooperative House Building Societies. The work of demarcation in the Rohtak Road area has nearly been completed and a date has been provisionally fixed in the next month for showing the demarcated plots to the respective Cooperative Societies.

- (b) The possession of land is likely t_0 be handed over in the next two months after completing necessary formalities.
- (c) The individual Societies are required to develop the land.
- (d) The Societies will be required to complete the development within a period of three years from the date on which the possession of the land is handed over to them.
