\*678. SHRI J. P. YADAV : Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state :

(a) the number of Corporations (such as Food Corporation, Heavy Engineering Corporation, Life Insurance Corporation) so far set up by Government and the basis on which Government have been making nominations of the Board of Directors and Chairmen of these Corporations and how many of them are Government officials and members of Congress or Opposition Parties;

(b) the names of the present Corporations together with the names of their Chairmen and the period of their tenure; and

(c) whether Government propose to make changes in its present policies relating to the appointments in these Corporations ?]

**CENSOR OF FILM 'SPY IN ROME'**

\*67Q. SHRIMATI SARLA BHADAURIA : Will the Minister of INFORMATION and BROADCASTING be pleased to state;

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the film 'Spy in Rome' wherein India have been called fools; and

(b) if so, the circumstances in which the film was passed by the Censors and the action Government propose to take in the matter ?

THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING

(SHRI K. K. SHAH): (a) Yes, Sir, through a press comment which appeared in 'Shravya Drishya Kalayen' column of Nagpur Bulletin (a Hindi Fortnightly) criticising the dialogue 'Isi liye Hindustan ko bewaqoofon ka mulk kaha gaya hai, occuring in the film 'Spy in Rome'.

(b) The dialogue in question is spoken out of frustration by villain, an enemy of India, for the Indian scientist who does not yield to temptation to disclose the secret formula and undergoes tortures at the hands of the villain. The Intent and purpose of the dialogues is to bring out by contrast the good quality of an Indian scientist against the viles of a villain. No action is therefore, proposed be taken by Government.

**SABAH ISSUE**

SHRI R. P. SINHA :

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state whether Government propose to take some steps to ease tension between Malaysia and Philippines over the Sabah issue in order to ease the situation in South East Asia ?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI SURENDRA PAL SINGH) : Hon. Members will appreciate that in the context of tension over the delicate situation when both sides are actually engaged in negotiations, it will not be desirable to give public expression to our views on this issue.

Malaysia and the Philippines are both aware of our approach to this question. It is our earnest and sincere hope that the issue will be resolved bilaterally.

Honourable Members may have seen Press reports that the Deputy Prime Minister of Malaysia and the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs of the Philippines have just concluded an agreement according to which the question of Sabah will be settled amicably between the two countries.

#### AMBASSADORS TO LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES

\*681. SHRI M. P. BHARGAVA : Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state :

(a) Whether it is proposed to appoint any new Indian Ambassadors in any of the Latin American Countries ;

(b) whether any Latin America<sup>11</sup> countries have expressed their intention of appointing their Ambassadors or Trade Representatives in India; and

(c) what are the Latin American countries with which we have diplomatic relations at present ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI B. R. BHAGAT) :

(a) No, Sir; not for the present. However, two new Missions are being opened in the next few months in Caracas (Venezuela) and Lima (Peru) at the level of Charge d'Affaires.

(b) Nine Latin American countries have diplomatic representation in India. Recently Paraguay has also decided to accredit its Ambassador resident in Tokyo simultaneously to represent the country in New Delhi.

(c) A statement is laid on the Table of the House.
