## TRUCKS GIFTED TO INDIA BY THE POPE

177. DR. BHAI MAHAVIR : Will the Minister of TRANSPORT AND SHIPPING be pleased to state :

(a) whether it is a fact that 60 trucks gifted to India by the Pope in 1966 have been rendered useless without being put to any use;

(b) whether any inquiry has been made into the matter; and

(c) if so, what action has been taken in the matter to fix responsibility for the same ?

THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT AND SHIPPING (PROF. V.K.R.V. RAO) : (a) to (c) 40 trucks were received from the Pope in 1966 and they are being used for transportation of foodgrain.

## THEFT OF ANTIQUES FROM THE NATIONAL MUSEUM, DELHI

## 178. SHRI ARJUN ARORA SHRI YELLA REDDY :

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to refer to the Calling Attention Notice regarding the theft of antiques from the National Museum, Delhi, discussed in the Rajya Sabha on August 30, 1968, and state :

(a) the further steps taken to recover the antiques;

(b) the steps already taken towards greater security of the valuables in our Museums; and

(c) whether the promised committee has been appointed ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (PROF. SHER SINGH): (a) The

police who have been investigating the matter have recovered 107 items of jewellery out of the 125 items of jewellery stolen from the National Museum. In addition they have recovered 1,200 grams of gold suspected to be melted out of the stolen coins and some of the jewellery. Four persons have been arrested by the police in this connection. Police investigations are still continuing.

(b) and (c) Government have set up a Committee of Museum experts to go into the organisation and administration of the three Central Museums and also to make recommendations for strengthening the security arrangements in these Museums and the protected archaeological monuments and sites. Further steps towards greater security of valuables in our Museums and in the protected archaeological monuments and sites will be taken in the light of the recommendations which this Committee will make. The recommendations of the Committee will also be brought to the notice of the State Governments and Museums authorities throughout the country for adoption by these authorities to the extent considered necessary and feasible. In the meantime the following steps have been taken or are contemplated for strengthening the existing security arrangements in the National Museum, New Delhi

(i) The ventilators, drainage and water pipes leading to the windows and terraces are being covered with barbed wire.

(ii) All the windows and other vulnerable points on the ground, first and second floors are being provided with iron grills.

(iii) All the doors leading to the galleries have been provided with extra sliding bolts and tower bolts.

(iv) Iron gates are proposed to be provided ai the entrance and exit of the Museum building.

(v) Proposal for installation of electric alarms system is under consideration.

(vi) Tell-tale clocks are proposed to be installed on each floor inside the building and at 2 or 3 places outside the building.
