(a) to (c) Precise data regarding the claims of Indian nationals in Burma have not yet been compiled, but the number of cases involved is about 2,000. The Government of Burma have appointed a Committee to go into the question. The Committee has not completed its work but we have been assured that they are actively pursuing the matter.

- (b) The pay scales of officers correspond generally to the pay scales of comparable civil officers of the Central Government. Pay, allowances and concessions received free or in kind as a condition of service by other ranks, taken together, are not less than the emoluments of civil employees of Central Government of a comparable kind.
