THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SARDAR SWARAN SINGH): (a) and (b) This broad question is now engaging the attention of the Government of India.

#### POSSESSION OF BALLISTIC MISSILES BY CHINA

236. SHRI J. S. TILAK : Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state :

(a) whether Government are aware that China will possess this year a deployment of a medium-range ballistic missiles and will shortly thereafter be able to deploy a long-range inter-continental ballistic missile ;

(b) if so, whether this involves a serious threat to India as well as the whole of Asia ; and

(e) what action Government propose to take to meet this threat ?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SARDAR SWARAN SINGH): (a) to (c) As stated in the House on 25th July, 1968, in reply to Unstarred Question No. 251, China has been laying considerable emphasis on the production of medium range ballistic missiles with nuclear warheads. Considering the pace of Chinese nuclear development so far, China's first deployment of a limited number of medium range missiles may not be far away. The Chinese may achieve an operational ICBM capability before 1972. These developments could represent a potential threat to peace. Their effect on our security is a subject of continuous review by Government. The attitude of Government on nuclear weapons has been made clear on a number of occasions.

(b) if so, what additional steps are taken by the Government of India to counteract the same ?]

प्रधान मंत्री तथा वंदेशिक कार्य मंत्री (श्रीमती इन्दिरा गांधी) : (क) जी हाँ, यह सच है कि चीन और पाकिस्तान, दोनों बराबर भारत विरोधी प्रचार करते हैं, और भारत के भीतर भी कुछ तत्वों को उकसाते हैं ।

(ख) सरकार की सूचना के अनुसार विदेशों में इस प्रचार का कोई असर नहीं होता । इसलिए कोई और कदम उठाना आवश्यक नहीं समझा जाता । बहरहाल, इसका प्रतिकार करने के लिए विदेश-स्थित अपने मिशन को बराबर समुचित सामग्री भेजी जाती रहती है ।
