The Prime Minister proposes to visit the following countries immediately after the termination of the current session of Parliament: Singapore from the 19 to 20 May 1968, Australia 21 to 26 May 1968, New Zealand 27 to 28 May 1968, and Malaysia 29 to 31 May 1968.

(c) Although the composition of the Prime Minister's party has not yet been finalised, it will, as on previous occasions, broadly follow the normal pattern.]

wal of their forces from the East of Suez with the Government of India;

(b) if so, what was the attitude of the Government of India in the matter;

(c) whether the other countries in the region discussed this matter with the Government of India; and

(d) what is the Government of India's assessment of the impact of the withdrawal of British forces from this area?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI SURENDRA PAL SINGH): (a) No, Sir'.

(b) Does not arise.

(c) Some countries in the area have exchanged views regarding this matter with the Government of India.

(d) The Government of India's assessment is that the withdrawal of British forces from the area East of Suez is part of the historic process of the withdrawal of Britain's imperial interests in the area. Hereafter, the responsibility to ensure the security and independence of the States in the area will, inevitably, devolve on them. Government of India have no doubt that this security can be achieved without the intervention of outside Powers.
