- (b) The suggestions made therein are:—
 - 1. Visakhapatnam should relay Hyderabad Vijayawada programmes in the morning and mid-day also.
- 2. The status of Visakhapatnam should be improved from a relaying to a broadcasting centre.
- (c) The suggestions mean additional funds and also involve conversion of auxiliary stations into Programme-originating stations, which means additional studies and staff. The suggestions have not been found feasible owing to financial stringency.

A. I. R. SENTION IN HARYANA

- 150. SHRI R. P. KHAITAN: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:
- (a) whether a final decision has been taken about the place where the A.I.R. Station in the State of Haryana will be located;
- (b) if so, what is the name of the place; and
- (c) if the answer to part (a) above be in the negative, how much more time will be taken by Government to come to a final decision?

THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI K. K. SHAH): (a) No, Sir.

- (b) Does not arise.
- (c) The Draft Fourth Five Year Plan for the development of broadcasting includes a provision for the setting up of a Radio Station in Haryana State. Its actual installation, however, depends upon the availability of resources and necessary exchange. The ultimate location of the Capital may also take some time.
