

PRABHU): (a) The National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority (NPPA) has been entrusted, *inter alia*, with the task of fixation/revision of the prices of scheduled drugs and formulations based thereon under the provisions of the Drugs (Prices Control) Order, 1995 issued under the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 and for monitoring the prices. Decisions on pricing of medicines are taken by NPPA in accordance with the statutory provisions of the Drugs (Prices Control) Order, 1995. As per price index of pharmaceutical formulations, compiled by Operations Research Group (ORG-MARG), the price index (Base-1994-100), during the year 1999, increased by 4.09% over the preceding year.

(b) The Drug Policy, as amended from time to time, is directed towards ensuring the availability of quality drugs at reasonable prices.

(c) Some pharmaceutical industry associations in the country have urged removal of price controls on drugs and pharmaceuticals.
