TENDERS IN CONNECTION WITH THE CON-
STRUCTION OF BUILDINGS FOR UNCTAD II

285. SHRI ARJUN ARORA:
SHRI A. P. CHATTERJEE:

Will the Minister of WORKS,
HOUSING AND SUPPLY be pleased
to state:

(a) whether any tenders were in-
vited for the construction of Curzon
Road, Hostel, extension of Vigyan
Bhawan and other buildings in Delhi
in connection with UNCTAD II; and

(b) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF WORKS, HOUSING AND SUPPLY (SARDAR IQBAL SINGH): (a) and (b) Having regard to the need for quality and execution within a short time, tenders for the building work (including sanitary and water installations) of the two projects were invited from 24 selected contractors of proved capacity and with requisite financial and technical resources. Open tenders were invited for works of internal electrical installations in both the buildings and modifications to the sound system in Vigyan Bhavan. The various works were awarded to the lowest tenderers. The contract on woodwork in the Hostel at Curzon Road was awarded by negotiations to the Hindustan Housing Factory who alone possessed the required capacity for seasoning the wood in time.

KING GEORGE V STATUE

287. SARDAR NARINDAR SINGH BRAR: Will the Minister of WORKS, HOUSING AND SUPPLY be pleased to state the reasons for not removing the statue of King George V from the India Gate, New Delhi so far?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF WORKS, HOUSING AND SUPPLY (SARDAR IQBAL SINGH): According to the general policy of Government, the statues of British Monarchs and Viceroy in the Capital are being removed gradually. All the statues except that of King George V have been removed. It will also be removed in two to three months' time after making arrangements for keeping it.

DEATHS DUE TO CANCER

288. SARDAR NARINDAR SINGH BRAR: Will the Minister of HEALTH, FAMILY PLANNING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the number of deaths that took place in the country due to cancer in the year 1967;

(b) whether Government are aware that a medicine has been developed in Japan to control and eradicate cancer; and

(c) if so, what efforts are being made to develop such a medicine in India?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH, FAMILY PLANNING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI B. S. MURTHY): (a) The information is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the Rajya Sabha in due course.

(b) and (c) The Government of India are aware that the following medicines have been introduced in Japan to control and treat cancer during the last ten years:—

1. Nitromin.
2. Sarkomycin.
3. Merphyrin.

These medicines are proprietary drugs which are not manufactured in India.
