

COMPLAINT OF KERALA CHIEF MINISTER AGAINST CENTRE

***234. SHRI HARISH CHANDRA MATHUR:** Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to Kerala Chief Minister's complaint that Kerala's important problems cannot be solved unless the Centre discharged its duties to the State; and

(b) what is the nature of his complaints and Government's reaction to it?

THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI Y. B. CHAVAN): (a) and (b) According to information furnished by the State Government, the criticism is in regard to (1) uneven industrial development and consequent accentuation of the problem of unemployment and (2) rice allocations to the State. The Cen-

tral Government are doing all they can to help the State. Allegations of discrimination against Kerala are not correct.
