[THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE (DR. SHRIMATI PHUL-RENU GUHA): (a) Programmes for Scheduled Tribes in the Welfare of Backward Classes Sector are not formulated for individual tribes. However, the programmes undertaken by the Government of Madhya Pradesh for the welfare of Adivasis in Abujmarh (Bastar District) include:—

- (i) tribal Development Block in operation since 1965-66; and
- (ii) nine Centres, each with a school, a co-operative store and a medical unit.

(b) There is no special scheme in the Backward Classes Welfare Sector for Madhya Pradesh.]

INCOME-TAX ARREARS FROM CINEMA HOUSES IN DELHI

76. SHRIMATI SARLA BHADARIA: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) the arrears of Income-Tax due at present from the following cinema houses in Delhi: (1) Amba, (2) Plaza, (3) Odeon, (4) Regal, (5) Palace, (6) Vivek, (7) Ajanta, (8) Ritz (P) Ltd., (9) Golcha, and (10) Delite;

(b) the amount of Income-Tax paid during the last five years by the said cinema houses, cinema-wise and year-wise; and

(c) whether any case of tax evasion has been found in respect of these cinema houses?

THE DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF FINANCE (SHRI MORARJI R. DESAI): (a) to (c) The required information is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the House as early as possible.

GAUHATI REFINERY

77. DR. (MRS.) MANGLADEVI TALWAR: Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS be pleased to state the details of the nature and extent of oil, gas and other petroleum products available from the Gauhati Refinery for use in the petrochemical industries in the country?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS AND OF SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRI K. RAGHURAMIAH): The production of petroleum products at Gauhati Refinery during 1967 was 711,728 tonnes. Of these, 150,000 tonnes of light distillates and 27,000 tonnes of Refinery gases could be utilised in petrochemical industries.

RAJASTHAN CANAL PROJECT

78. DR. (MRS.) MANGLADEVI TALWAR: Will the Minister of IRRIGATION AND POWER be pleased to state the present stage of progress achieved on the Rajasthan Canal Project?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF IRRIGATION AND POWER (PROF. SIDDHESHWAR PRASAD): The entire 134 miles length of the Rajasthan Feeder and the first 48.6 miles length of the Rajasthan Main Canal have been completed. Work is in progress between mile 48.6 and mile 70.
