THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF WORKS, HOUSING AND SUPPLY (SARDAR IQBAL SINGH): (a) On the 7th March 1967.

(b) About Rs. 60,000 were spent on essential alterations and repairs before the shifting. There are some essential repairs to be done to the verandahs and it is proposed to shift the High Court from this building to another one temporarily for a period of three months or so while these repairs are completed. This is desirable to avoid noise and inconvenience to the High Court.
