Nicobar and neighbouring islands the achievements of India after freedom in the various fields of national life and for publicising the various steps being taken to improve the living conditions of the people of the above region in all spheres?

THE MINISTER OF INFORMA-TION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI K. K. SHAH): Publicity in the Andaman and Nicobar islands on India's achievements in various national life are carried out through various media like Field Publicity Unit, Information Centres, community listening sets, etc. The local station of the All India Radio at Port Blair also relays important programmes and speeches from the mainland. Block agencies in Panchayats and Social and Cultural Organisations also publicise the country's achievements. The Administration brings out a daily newspaper called the 'Daily Telegram' which publishes suitable articles besides news and comment on current affairs.

DEFENCE AND POLICE FORCES IN THE ANDAMANS

398. SHRI JAIRAMDAS DAULAT-RAM: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the proposals which are under Government's consideration for increasing the amenities and meeting the requirements of the defence and police forces stationed in the Andaman Nicobar and neighbouring islands; and

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI M. R. KRISHNA): (a) and (b). A proposal for increasing the rate of Andaman Allowance in respect of the Defence Forces personnel stationed n the Andaman Nicobar group of slands is under consideration. A decision will be taken as early as possible. No proposal for the Police Forces is under consideration.

- (a) whether a delegation of four Congress M P's. left for Africa in January, 1968 on a goodwill mission;

- (c) the reasons for which no Member belonging to opposition party was invited to join the delegation?

THE PRIME MINISTER (SHRI-MATI INDIRA GANDHI): group of four Members of Parliament, namely, Shri Narendrasingh Mahida (Convenor), Shri Prasan Vadan Mehta (Member), Shri C. M. (Member) and Kedaria Santokh Singh (Member), undertook a tour of some East African countries in January 1968.

(b) and (c). As the trip was undertaken by the Members themselves, the question of inviting others did not arise.
