

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD, AGRICULTURE, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND COOPERATION (SHRI ANNASAHAB SHINDE) : (a) to (c) Under the existing system of crop estimation, a time schedule has been laid down for reporting of estimates of area and production in respect of different crops by the States to the Government of India. According to this schedule, firm estimates of production in respect of the principal rabi foodgrains *viz.*, wheat, barley and gram, are due to be received by the end of May, 1968. However, according to periodical reports on weather and crop conditions received from the States and other available information, the prospects of rabi crops are bright.

#### REGISTRATION OF BOGUS VOTERS IN HARYANA STATE

1044. SHRI JAGAT NARAIN: Will the Minister of LAW be pleased to state:

(a) whether it has come to Government's notice that a large number of bogus voters have been registered from the adjoining villages of Rajasthan in the Hissar District of the State of Haryana, particularly in the Ellenabad constituency of that State;

(b) what was the number of voters registered in the Ellenabad constituency of the Haryana State at the time of last General Elections; and

(c) the number of voters registered up to the 1st March, 1968.

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF LAW (SHRI MOHD. YUNUS SALEEM): (a) The Election Commission has received complaints that a large number of bogus voters from villages of Rajasthan adjoining Ellenabad assembly constituency in

the Hissar District of Haryana State had lodged claims for inclusion in the electoral roll of that constituency. The Commission has taken appropriate action to check each claim by an on the spot verification.

(b) The number of voters registered in the Ellenabad constituency at the time of the last general elections was 56,092.

(c) The electoral roll of the constituency is in the process of revision and the final rolls will be published only on 30th March 1968.

#### **INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT OF RESOURCES IN BASTAR**

963. SHRI V. M. CHORDIA: Will the Minister of LABOUR AND REHABILITATION be pleased to state :

(a) whether it is a fact that the former Finance Minister, Shri T. T. Krishnamachari had initiated proposals for the integrated development of resources in Bastar region mainly for the betterment of the conditions of the Adivasis and settlement of new migrants from East Pakistan and other Indian repatriates;

(b) if so, what are the details of the proposals;

(c) what steps have been taken by the Government of India to implement these proposals; and

(d) if so, what is Government's reaction thereto?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR, EMPLOYMENT AND REHABILITATION (SHRI D. R. CHAVAN): (a) to (d): The former Finance Minister (Shri T. T.

Krishnamachari) and the former Rehabilitation Minister (Shri Mahavir Tyagi) visited Dandakaranya in November, 1961. From the available data it appeared to them that there were certain possibilities for the establishment of industries based on the mineral and forest resources. However, further investigations and surveys had to be carried out before specific schemes could be formulated.

The suggestions since made by two expert teams engaged in a technoeconomic appraisal and an appraisal of the irrigation and power potentialities of the area are now under various stages of study and consideration by the concerned authorities.

#### **SAVINGS FROM WITHDRAWAL OF SUBSIDY**

937. SHRI SITARAM JAIPURTA : Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) what is the total saving on account of withdrawal of all sorts of subsidy on wheat and partial withdrawal of subsidy on milo and rice during the current financial year; and

(b) what is the expected saving on this account during the next financial year?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD, AGRICULTURE, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND COOPERATION (SHRI ANNASAHEB SHINDE): (a) The saving estimated during the financial year 1967-68 is about Rs. 12 crores.
