संसद-कार्य तथा संचार विभागों में राज्य मंत्री (श्री आई० के० गुजराल) : (क) जी नहीं विज्ञान भवन में अंकटाइ के प्रसंग में काम करने वाले केन्द्रीय सरकार के कर्मचारियों को ये भत्ते नहीं मिलते, ये भत्ते विज्ञान भवन में या दिल्ली में अन्यत्र अंकटाइ संगठन में काम करने वाले केवल उन्हीं कर्मचारियों को मिलते हैं जिनकी वहां प्रतिनियुक्ति की गई है।

(ख) वेतन-मानों के अनुसार 25 प्रतिशत से 33-1/3 प्रतिशत तक की दर पर विशेष वेतन केवल उन्हीं कर्मचारियों को दिया गया है जो कि अंकटाइ-II संगठन, वाणिज्य मंत्रालय में काम करते हैं। चूंकि वहां काम करने वाले डाक-तार कर्मचारियों की अंकटाइ-II संगठन में प्रतिनियुक्ति नहीं हुई है, अतः उन्हें विशेष वेतन नहीं दिया गया।

[THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI I. K. GUJRAL): (a) No, Sir. Central Government employees working in Vigyan Bhawan in connection with the UNCTAD are not getting these allowances, except those on deputation to the Organisation of UNCTAD whether in Vigyan Bhawan or elsewhere in Delhi.

(b) Special pay at the rate of 25 per cent, to 33-1/3 per cent, according to pay scale has been granted only to

the members of staff working in the Organisation for UNCTAD-II, Ministry of Commerce. As the P. & T. staff working there are not on deputation to the UNCTAD-II Organisation, they have not been granted special pay].

UNLOADING OF FOODGRAINS AT KANDLA PORT

*767. DR. B. N. ANTANI: Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) the expenditure involved in movement of foodgrains by Railways and unloading from steamer at Kandla Port when the work was being done

by contract; and what is the cost today when this work is being done departmentally;

(b) what was the quantity of wastage previously and now;

(c) whether frequent complaints are received about shortage of fertiliser shipped by steamer at Kandla Port;

(d) the strength of staff employed for this work at Kandla; and

(e) what is the result of complaints received against local officers of the Food Department for delays in payment to those who had sold goods and for other irregularities?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD, AGRICULTURE, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND COOPERATION (SHRI ANNASAHEB SHINDE): (a) Only operations connected with the clearance of foodgrains from the port have been departmentalised at Kandla. In respect of this item of work the cost per tonne prior to departmentalisation was Rs. 3-24 and thereafter Rs. 3-41. The operations relating to unloading of foodgrains from the steamers have not been departmentalised. The departmentalisation has not affected movement of foodgrains by the Railways from this port or the Railway freight payable.

(b) Negligible. Figures regarding quantities involved are available.

(c) No, Sir.

(d) 2308 workers and about 100 other staff are employed on departmental operations at Kandla.

(e) Some complaints regarding delay in payments of bills relating to supplies of furniture, stationery and niriag of fans had been received. These were on account of some procedural delays which have since been settled.
