GUEST CONTROL ORDER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD, AGRICULTURE, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND COOPERATION (SHRI ANNASAHEB SHINDE) : (a) The Delhi Guest Control Order has been in force since 28th March 1964.

(b) 36 cases were instituted for violation of the provisions of the Order up to 12th November, 1967. The results of 24 were conviction and of 3 acquittal. Nine cases are pending trial.
