TRAFFIC HOLD-UP AT RAILWAY CROSSING NEAR GHOGRAPAR STATION

***563. SHRI SRIMAN PRAFULLA GOSWAMI :** Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state :

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to long and intermittent traffic hold-up at the Railway crossing on National Highway No 31 near Ghograpar Station on N F Railway in the district of Kamrup, due to frequent closure of gates ; and

(b) if so, the reasons for not shifting the crossing ?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI C. M. POONACHA) : (a) Yes, Madam.

(b) The proposal for shifting the level crossing was made to the State Government who have intimated that as it has already been proposed to divert National Highway No. 31 beyond the outer signal of Ghograpar station and to provide a road over-bridge, shifting of the level crossing would not be necessary.

TRAINS DETAINED BY STUDENTS ON SOUTHERN RAILWAY

1136. SHRI T. V. ANANDAN : Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state :

(a) whether it is a fact that on the 19th October, 1967, all trains bound for Howrah, Delhi and Hyderabad were detained for hours at PONNERI a Suburban railway Station on the Southern Railway due to students' demonstration, and

(b) if so, what are the details in this regard ?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI C. M. POONACHA) : (a) and (b) Yes. On 19-10-1967 about 300 students of Loganatha Narayanaswami Government College, Ponneri squatted on the track demanding stoppage of 38 Dn. Madras-Howrah Express train. As a result of this Nos. 38 Dn. Madras-Howrah Express and 89 Up Howrah-Madras Express were detained at Ponneri for about 6 hours and 5 hours respectively. Four other up trains were controlled at Madras Central, one down train at Sullurupeta and one at Gudur.
