t[CHANGES IN THE C.S.I.R.

1265. SHRIMATI VIDYAWATI CHATURVEDI : Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state :

(a) whether it is a fact that certain changes are proposed to be made in the administrative set-up of the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research at its Head Office; and

(b) if so, what are the details in this regard?]

शिक्षा मंत्री (डा० त्रिगुण सन) : (क) और (ख) ऐसा कोई प्रस्ताव विचाराधीन नहीं है। वैज्ञानिक तथा औद्योगिक अनुसंधान परिषद् के नियामक निकाय ने नवम्बर, 1967 को हुई अपनी पहिली बैठक में यह निर्णय किया था कि तकनीकी निदेशालय, वैज्ञानिक तथा औद्योगिक अनुसंधान महानिदेशालय के मुख्य कार्यालय के अंग होने चाहिए। उनका

कार्य वैज्ञानिक तथा औद्योगिक अनुसंधान महानिदेशालय की सहायता करना मात्र होना चाहिए और उनमें कार्यकारी परिषदें नहीं होनी चाहिए और निदेशालय के कार्यभारी अधिकारियों को राष्ट्रीय प्रयोगशालाओं के निदेशकों के जैसे अधिकार नहीं होने चाहिए।

t[THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (DR. TRIGUNA SEN) : (a) and (b) There is no such proposal under consideration except that the Governing Body of the C.S.I.R. at its last meeting held in November, 1967 decided that the Technical Directorates should be part of the Head-quarters establishment of the DGSIR, their functions being to assist the DGSIR, and that they should not have Executive Councils and the persons in charge of the Directorates should not have powers like the Directors of National Laboratories.]

PRIVATE PAPERS OF NATIONAL INTEREST

1266. SHRI M. C. SHAH: Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state :

(a) whether Government propose to compile a register of private collections of papers of national interest; and

(b) if so, the main details of the proposal ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (PROF. SHER SINGH) : (a) and (b) Government of India recognises the necessity for compilation of a National Register of all archival materials of significance in private custody. Although the implementation of the scheme is mainly the concern of the State Governments, the Government of India has accepted the responsibility of coordinating the work being done under the auspices of the former in this behalf, consolidating the results thereof, and also providing an annual grant-in-aid not exceeding Rs. 3,000 to each State.

The scheme aims at the compilation and maintenance of a full directory of information of all significant archival materials in the custody of and pertaining to all old and historical families, eminent personalities, religious, educational, scientific, learned and research bodies, business firms, banking houses,
