**WEST GERMAN ASSISTANCE FOR  
DEVELOPMENT OF AGRICULTURE**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD, AGRICULTURE, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND CO-OPERATION (SHRI ANNASAHAB SHINDE): (a) The Government of Federal Republic of Germany have made available at its cost, to the project, the following assistance to-date:—

(i) Services of six experts;

(ii) Training facilities in the Federal Republic of Germany for 4 officers of the Government of Madras; and

(iii) Equipment and fertilisers costing Rs. 12.43 lakhs.
