INTERNATIONAL TOURIST YEAR

◆725. SHRI M. C. SHAH: Will the Minister of TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state the steps taken by Government to encourage Tourism during the International Tourist Year in the country?

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (DR. KARAN SINGH): The two main objectives of the International Tourist Year were promoting travel to India and creating an awareness of the importance of tourism within the country.
