

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD, AGRICULTURE, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND COOPERATION (SHRI ANNASAHEB SHINDE): (a) to (c) Government have not seen the statement of the Education Minister of Kerala about the offer of one lakh tonnes of rice by a foreign firm with headquarters at Singapore. A Singapore firm had offered 50,000 tonnes and subsequently a further quantity of 100,000 tonnes of Italian rice on behalf of its principals in Europe. The offers were not accepted as enquiries made by Government revealed that the offers were not genuine and were unlikely to materialise.

STATEMENT

(a) Yes, Sir.

(b) During 1966-67 an outlay of Rs. 145 lakhs was utilised in the State to create irrigation facilities from surface water, storage and diversion works. The groundwater development on which an expenditure of Rs. 351.251 lakhs was incurred, contributed to the creation of the following additional facilities:

(1) Construction of wells	18,000*
(2) Deepening of wells	37,061
(3) Boring in wells	74
(4) Drilling of tubewells	54
(5) Installation of pump sets	5,570
(6) Installation of persian wheels	6,355

*16,000 wells were constructed by the cultivators from their own resources.

In addition to the above, 166 successful tubewells for irrigation/drinking water purposes have been constructed in West Rajasthan by the E. T. O. of the Government of India under the special programme taken up in 1965.

(c) The emphasis on Minor Irrigation is being maintained.
