carrying higher fixed salary for being given only to scientists who have made outstanding contribution to either increasing crop production or for the advancement of human knowledge. The basic objective is that advancement of any scientist should be based solely on his ability and competence which should be assessed periodically by a group of competent scientists. The level at which a scientist is recruited should not be based on the level of the post that may be vacant at the time of recruitment but a post should always be created commensurate with the scientific attainment of the candidate. Similarly, the advancement of a scientist should not be delayed or blocked because of the nonavailability of appropriate posts at higher levels. Whenever a scientist is considered fit for promotion by the Selection Committee, his pay-scale should be changed automatically even though he may be holding the same post.

4. The proposal which has been under consideration of the Government, could not be finalised so far due mainly to the ban imposed in June 1966 in The wake of devaluation, against any upward revision of pay-structure at any level. It is now proposed to first rationalise the existing pay-scales of the agricultural scientists and after this has been done, to constitute the Service. The matter is under consideration of the Government.
